Binomial Nomenclature

A system for naming living organisms by means of two Latin names: the first indicating the genus and the second the species to which the organism belongs, as in *Acer saccharum* (the sugar maple).

Governed by the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature (ICBN).



Family

A broad classification that will help us understand distant plant group characteristics.

❖ Genus

A broad classification of plants with slightly similar characteristics.

Species

A group of plants with identical characteristics able to breed and produce similar offspring.

Variety

A group that is distinguished from other groups by a specific characteristic or set of characteristics.

Subspecies

Usually occurs because of isolation within a species.

Cultivar

A plant that has been created or selected intentionally and maintained through cultivation, it usually cannot reproduce if left to its own devices.

❖ Family

Capitalize, lower case



❖ Genus Cornus

Capitalize, lower case (if in print media use italics)

❖ Species florida

Lower case (if in print media use italics)

❖ Variety: var. rubra

Lower case (if in print media use italics)
Variety is written as var.

❖ Subspecies: ssp.

❖ A rare occurrence

Lower case (if in print media use italics)
Subspecies is written as ssp.
